CAMP COST

\$475 (\$375 for commuters): Includes room and board, use of recreational facilities, jersey & shorts, instruction, and competition. (Commuters receive lunch & dinner, but no housing.)

CAMP DEPOSIT

\$250: Non-refundable after June 1 (any refunds incur a \$50 service fee). Balance will be billed in May. Further information, directions, and final details will be mailed/e-mailed one month prior to the start of camp.

CHECK-IN/OUT

Check-in is between 12 and 1 p.m. on June 23rd. There will be a camp meeting at 2:30 p.m. The 1st field session begins at 3 p.m. Check-out is at 12 p.m. on June 27th.
